



RLA Kids Weekly Devotional Guide

November 29, 2020

Remember: this guide is meant to help facilitate conversations and engagement with Jesus throughout the week, so don't feel like you need to do this all in one day!

What We're Learning This Week

“THE HOPE OF GOD”
NUMBERS 27:12-23

God brought Moses to the top of a mountain to see the Promised Land and to remind him that his sin would keep him from arriving there with his people. The story captures three major things we learned in the book of Numbers: that God is always faithful to His people/His covenant, that God is merciful but also a righteous judge of sin, and that God is always with His people in the wilderness. Because of Jesus, we can always have hope in the promises of God.

Discipleship Through Scripture + Conversation

Talk to your kids about the Bible lesson they watched on video. Ask them to explain what they learned/ what stuck out to them in the video, and expand upon the truths of the Bible that they are bringing up. Some helpful conversations this week could be:

- 1. Let's walk through each of these main themes. The first one is: God is always faithful to His people and His covenant.**
 - How have we seen these truths in the book of Numbers? What does it mean that God is faithful?
 - What is a covenant? How are God's promises trustworthy? What ways are we prone to forget that, and what ways can we be reminded?
- 2. God is merciful, but He is also a righteous judge of sin.**
 - What does this tell us about God's character? What does it tell us about sin?
 - How does the judgement of God impact how you view Him? In what ways does it push us to trust and/or to fear God? How does it shape the way we live?
- 3. God is always with His people in the wilderness.**
 - How have we seen these truths in the book of Numbers? What comfort does this bring? How can we know that we are never alone with God?

4. Through Jesus, we can always have hope.

- In what ways do we need to be rescued? In what ways is Jesus our ultimate Rescuer? How is He our Savior? Our Provider?
- How is Jesus our ultimate hope?

Discipleship Through Prayer

- Spend time this week praising God for these truths. Pray for the hope of Christ to overcome your hearts and to shape your lives. Continue to pray for everything surrounding the coronavirus, the election, and racial equality in our country - for safety, for healing, for unity, and for specific people you can serve as a family.
- Ask each member of your family – adults included – to share one thing they would like prayer over. Have someone to pray for that person's request. Encourage your family to pray for that person for the entire week.
