How to Participate

WHAT YOU’LL NEED

- [This recording of “O Come Let Us Adore Him.”](#) This is the version everyone will be using, so please stick to it! You can also [download the lyrics](#).
- A phone or computer with video-recording capability.
- A quiet environment with decent lighting in which to record.
- Your best Christmas outfit ever! (Not required but...come on, it will be so cute!)

HOW TO RECORD AND SUBMIT

1. Set your recording equipment up and run a test. [Here’s a link to some basic lighting and framing techniques](#).
2. Practice singing the song together as a family for a few days before recording, especially practicing how to sing along with the music track.
3. Help set your child up in the right spot. Set up the camera in a stationary spot and film them from the chest up. Press record, wait a few seconds, have them say their name, and then clap. The clap will help us synch the mixed voices with the video.
 - (If the kids want to add in hand motions or dance along that is totally fine with us! Let’s just make sure they stay on camera as they do.)
4. Play the track. If there is one child, it may be useful to have them wear headphones so they can sing along and we won’t hear the background track. If there are multiple children singing together then you can play the music in the background, but try to keep it on the quieter end so we can be sure to hear their voices come through nice and loud!
5. Once you have your recording of the song, [upload the files to this dropbox folder](#). Please upload your video no later than midnight, **Friday, December 11**.

That’s it! We’ll mix and edit all the submissions together and get to delightful experience being led in worship by the wonderful kids in our church during our Christmas gathering!
