

RLA Kids Weekly Devotional Guide

April 18, 2021

Remember: this guide is meant to help facilitate conversations and engagement with Jesus throughout the week, so don't feel like you need to do this all in one day!

What We're Learning This Week

“THE CERTAINTY OF GOD’S PROMISES”

HEBREWS 6:13-20

When God makes a promise He keeps it - every single time. This Scripture in Hebrews 6 reminds us of that AND it tells us that He secures those promises with an unchanging, unbreakable oath. God is fully trustworthy and He never changes. That means God is our anchor, and we are fixed and secure in Him. Because of the Gospel we no longer need to be perfect to approach a perfect God - Jesus has done that for us. We just need to trust in Him and make Him our anchor.

Discipleship Through Scripture + Conversation

Talk to your kids about the Bible lesson they watched on video. Ask them to explain what they learned/ what stuck out to them in the video, and expand upon the truths of the Bible that they are bringing up. Some helpful conversations this week could be:

1. Hebrews 6 reminds us of God’s promise and oath to Abraham and how those reflect who God is.

- What promises did God make to Abraham? How did He fulfill them? What does that tell us about who God is? What are other examples of God’s promises that you can find in Scripture?
- What is an oath? How can God both make an oath and be the one responsible for the oath? What does that tell us about God’s character?
- What are some ways you find it hard to trust God’s promises? What parts of the Gospel are you not remembering when you do that?

2. Hebrews 6 also reminds us that our unchanging God is our anchor.

- What does it mean that God is the anchor for our souls? Why does this matter? What are other things that our souls are tempted to be anchored in?
- How has Jesus earned us access to the unchanging, perfect God? How can we respond?

Discipleship Through Prayer

- Spend time this week praising God for His perfection, His trustworthiness, and His unchanging nature! Pray for God help you confess your sins and areas where you are putting your trust instead of His

promises, knowing Jesus has rescued us through his death and resurrection and is continuing this process with you and in you. Continue to pray for everything surrounding the coronavirus, politics, and racial equality in our country - for safety, for healing, for unity, and for specific people you can serve as a family.

- Ask each member of your family – adults included – to share one thing they would like prayer for. Have someone to pray for that person’s request. Encourage your family to pray for that person for the entire week.
