

# Reality LA Kids Weekly Devotional Guide

November 7, 2021

Remember: this guide is meant to help facilitate conversations and engagement with Jesus throughout the week, so don't feel like you need to do this all in one day!

## What We're Learning This Week

"DANIEL"  
*THE BOOK OF DANIEL*

The book of Daniel highlights a life lived with faithfulness. Daniel's life shows us what it looks like to trust God even when things seem stacked against you. Daniel points us forward to Jesus, who conquered our greatest enemies and brings us new life!

## Discipleship Through Scripture + Conversation

Talk to your kids about the Bible lesson. Ask them to explain what they learned/what stuck out to them in the video, and expand upon the truths of the Bible that they are bringing up. Some helpful conversations this week could be:

- 1. Daniel chose to follow God and God's commands, even when it meant going against the ways of the Babylonian people and leaders.**
  - What does it mean that God is holy? What does it mean that followers of God are holy? What does it look like to live "holy lives" today?
  - How does Scripture tell us to live in/engage in the world around us? In what ways is that encouraging? In what ways is that challenging? How does God lead us in this?
- 2. God protected Daniel every step of his life, including in the den of lions!**
  - How did God protect Daniel from the evil plans of the other leaders? How did God protect Daniel in the den of lions? What does this tell us about who God is and how we can trust in Him?
  - How did Daniel's faithfulness and trust in God impact the lives of others? What does that encourage us to do/how does it shape how you live?
  - How does the story of Daniel point us to Jesus? How does Jesus protect us, conquer our enemies, and bring us true, new life?

## Discipleship Through Prayer

Spend time this week praising God for the ways that He protects His people and His trustworthiness. Pray for a trust in God's promises and a trust in His ways. Pray for God to equip with you what you need to both follow Him faithfully and to love/engage with your neighbors.

Continue to pray for everything surrounding the coronavirus, politics, and racial equality in our country - for safety, for healing, for unity, and for specific people you can serve as a family.

- Ask each member of your family – adults included – to share one thing they would like prayer for. Have someone to pray for that person's request. Encourage your family to pray for that person for the entire week.
