what we learned

God promised that the Messiah, the king of the world, would come from David's family. God kept His promise by sending His Son Jesus as one of David's descendants. Jesus is our perfect King who will rule over God's people forever.

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- David wanted to honor God by making Him a large house, but God didn't ask for it. He instead reminded David of all that He (God) had done for David and for the His people.
 - What had God done for David? How do you think that affected David's ability to trust God's promise about the future?
 - How does reflecting on the faithfulness of God throughout the Bible and in our own lives help us to trust God's promises?
 - Who would ultimately be the one who would perfectly build God's kingdom on earth? How did He do it?
- 2. The promises God made to His people in that day are still true today.
 - Why is God's covenant with David special to us today? Who does that covenant ultimately foreshadow? How did God keep His promise to David?
 - How does something that happened so long ago apply to our lives today?
 - Why is it better to live in God's kingdom rather than to live for ourselves?
