

# EASTER SUNDAY!

## WHAT WE LEARNED

He is risen! We celebrate the life, death, and resurrection of Jesus, remembering that our sin has brought about brokenness and separation from God, but Jesus has come to bring the Kingdom of God, to rescue His people, and to offer new life to all who put their faith in Him.

## DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

**God created everything perfect; sin ruined it; Jesus rescued and renewed it all; and He will restore His creation fully one day.**

1. Talk about the story of Scripture as a family. Discuss how God created, how humans and sin have ruined God's perfect culture, how Jesus has rescued and redeemed us, and how we are now called to partner with Him in creating culture.
  - Why does the death and resurrection matter? What do they mean about who God is? How do they change the way we know/love/follow God?
2. Ask your child to explain what the good news is to them. Help them to navigate through some common misconceptions (good works vs good news, religious behavior vs faithful following) and encourage them to reflect on the weight of the Gospel. Some questions to help spur this on could be:
  - What does the life, death, and resurrection of Jesus mean for you?
  - What is keeping you from trusting Jesus with your life today? Why? How is Jesus the answer to those doubts, fears, or lies?
  - What does a life of following Jesus look like? How does Jesus change the way you love your family? Your time at school? The things that give you worth? How is Jesus greater?

## MEMORY VERSE FOR THIS WEEK

## **PRAY TOGETHER**

Spend time this week praising Jesus for His life, death, and resurrection. Pray for God to reveal areas of your heart that you are prone to seek your own ways instead of His, ask Him to reveal why, and repent of those things. Pray for God to allow the truths of the Gospel to become real to you and to others.

Ask each member of your family – adults included – to share one thing they would like prayer for. Have someone to pray for that person’s request. Encourage your family to pray for that person for the entire week.
