

# ISAIAH, PROPHET TO JUDAH

Isaiah 6 + 53 Unit 15, Lesson 1

### WHAT WE LEARNED

The prophet Isaiah told people about the Messiah. God planned all along that Jesus would die on the cross for our sin. Seven hundred years before Jesus was born, the prophet Isaiah wrote that this would happen! Jesus is the Servant who suffered so that those who trust in Him would be forgiven.

## **DISCUSSION QUESTIONS**

- 1. Isaiah 6 opens with Isaiah's worshiping in the temple. God gave Isaiah a vision. Isaiah saw God sitting on a throne. God's holiness made Isaiah realize how great his own sin was!
  - What does it mean that God is holy? How is God different than His creation?
  - God took away Isaiah's guilt and extended His grace to Isaiah. What does this
    teach us about who God is? What does it tell us about who we are in relationship
    to God?
  - How else have you seen God extend forgiveness and kindness in Scripture and in your life?
- 2. In Isaiah 53 we see a vision of the promised Messiah, the innocent substitute who would suffer for the sake of sinners.
  - Who was this pointing forward to? How did Jesus fulfill the prophecies of the Suffering Servant?
  - Was Jesus, the Suffering Servant, suffering for His own sins or for ours? What does that tell us about who Jesus is and who we are in relationship to Him?
  - How does God uphold His promises to Abraham through Jesus?

forgive their sin and heal their land"

#### **PRAY TOGETHER**

Spend time this week praising God for the ways that He is committed to His people and the ways He has redeemed us. Pray and thank God for His perfect plan, that He sent His own Son to be the suffering servant who would take on our sin spot that those who trust in Him would be forgiven.

Ask each member of your family – adults included – to share one thing they would like prayer for. Have someone to pray for that person's request. Encourage your family to pray for that person for the entire week.
