Daniel 6 Unit 16, Lesson 2

WHAT WE LEARNED

God showed his power to rescue Daniel from the lions, but Daniel was just a small part of a much bigger story. God ultimately rescued us from a much bigger problem— sin and death— through His Son, Jesus.

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- Daniel chose to continue praying to God, even when the leaders told him that he would get punished for doing so. This shows that Daniel was faithful to God even when it was hard.
 - What do you think Daniel was feeling when he decided to pray to God knowing he could get into trouble? How does God meet us in our fear or worry?
 - Do you think that God was pleased by Daniel's faithfulness? How was God first faithful to David?
 - What does the Bible tell us about bravery, courage, and conviction in the midst of hardship? How was Daniel similar to Shadrach, Meshach and Abednago?
- 2. God remained faithful to Daniel and saved him from the lions' den. There was no harm to Daniel because he had trusted God and scripture says that Daniel was seen as blameless before God.
 - Scripture tells us that Daniel prayed to God three times a day. Why is praying important? Do you think that God heard Daniel's prayers?
 - Daniel trusted God and he was saved from the lions. When we trust God what are we saved from? How does Jesus help save us?
