Daniel 7 Unit 16, Lesson 4

WHAT WE LEARNED

Jesus is King over all things. God allows people to rule for a short time, but one day Jesus will return and set up His perfect kingdom. Everyone who trusts in Jesus will be welcomed into His kingdom, and His kingdom will last forever.

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- 1. The four beasts in the dream represent kings over people on the earth. The fourth one was even more scary and destructive than the first three and tried to change God's law (Daniel 7:25).
 - How should we feel about leaders who go against God?
 - God is still more powerful than the strongest kings in the world. Why is this good news for us?
 - Daniel asked God to teach him what the scary dream meant. Do you ask God to teach you? How have you seen God answer you when you are confused or scared?
- 2. Daniel's dream ends in verse 18 with God's people receiving the Kingdom forever.
 - · How does knowing this ending help us feel safe when bad things happen?
 - Romans 8:17 says that we are "joint-heirs" with Jesus. What do you love about having this free gift of God and partnering with God in loving others?

PRAY TOGETHER
